MONDAY: Please pray for the Christians of Sargodha (Punjab prov., Pakistan) who are threatened with mob violence following recent provocations towards Islam in Sweden that have caused anger in Pakistan; that He will keep them safe and grant them peace so that those who fled can return to their homes and those who have remained in the Christian quarter of Maryam Town will not be harmed or suffer false accusations of 'blasphemy'. TUESDAY: Please pray for Baher and all his fellow Christians in Egypt that they will be treated fairly and equally and that centuries of persecution towards the faithful remnant in that country will now abate; may His hand be over their communities and may He grant them grace and love to know true peace through His Son who grant what the world cannot. WEDNESDAY: Please pray for Reverend Samson in Myanmar (formerly Burma) who has been detained after praying with banned politicians, that he will be released unharmed & able to resume his ministry and that CSW's efforts to get British parliamentarians to act on his behalf and that of all our prisoners of conscience in Myanmar will bear much fruit. THURSDAY: Please pray for those Christians arrested across Iran (at least fifty and possibly as many as seventy) last month, that they will be well-treated and kept safe and strengthened by His presence and fortified by His Spirit and that He will watch over the churches they are part of in Tehran, Karaj, Rasht, Urumiyeh and Aligoudarz and keep them safe and that He will continue to bless the Iranian church that is bringing so many to salvation. FRIDAY: Please pray for all the Christians of Ushongo (Benue State, Nigeria) which was raided last month by those who hate their faith and covet their land and may those who mourn be comforted, may the churches and houses be rebuilt and may all the displaced be able to return to their farms and livelihoods and may He bless the ongoing 'Out of the Ashes' campaign to highlight injustice and persecution in Nigeria to the attention of the church in this country. SATURDAY: Please pray for all those rebuilding their lives after terrorist atrocities on their home, churches or places of work, that they will know His peace and be able to forgive and will be able to worship Him freely despite all that has been unjustly done to them.
