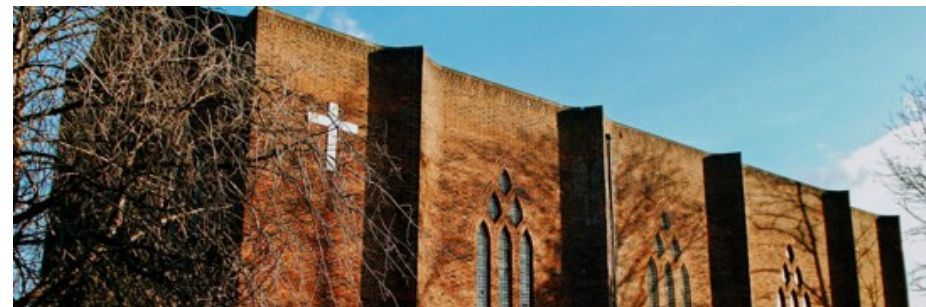
Such as:

MONDAY: Please pray for the families & friends of the forty killed or kidnapped in Dogon Noma (Kaduna state, Nigeria); that He will grant courage & strength to the bereaved, that He will redeem the kidnapped & bring them to places of safety and provision, that He will cause the persecution to end and the violence to stop and allow all to return to their homes and livelihoods as He brought Israel back from captivity. TUESDAY: Please pray for Please pray for the Guang Zhou Bible Reformed Church (China) which has been banned and for its Pastor Huang Xiao Ning who has proclaimed the good news of the risen Jesus Christ directly to his persecutors; that the boldness, perseverance and courage of both minister and congregation will be pleasing in Your sight and greatly blessed. WEDNESDAY: Please pray for all our brothers & sisters in Iran, especially those who have been arrested for their faith and await court summons (sometimes for years), especially Pastor Matthais Haghnejad and his wife Anahita Khademi, that they will receive true justice and be set free to continue to worship and praise You and that He will protect & deliver all those imprisoned for their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ or facing trial on unjust charges. THURSDAY: Please pray for the Christian people of Artsakh, known in Russian as Nagorno-Karabakh, who are enduring a nine-month blockade and now ceasefire-breaking shellfire by the government of Azerbaijan which persists in persecuting them despite condemnation by the United Nations; that He will sustain them & keep them safe in this time of trial. FRIDAY: Please pray for all our brothers & sisters in Jaranwala (Pakistan) where churches & Christian homes have been burned, Bibles burned and believers beaten, that He will protect & bless His people, change the hearts of those set on violence, injustice and division & allow the Word of truth and salvation be proclaimed freely throughout the land. SATURDAY: Please pray for Pastor Sidhu of Jaranwala (Pakistan) who is recovering from his wounds, after being shot for refusing to renounce his Saviour Lord, that He will bless His ministry and that many will be brought to salvation and hope in the Saviour of the World who died for us all. . SUNDAY: Please pray for St. Raphael's Church in Fadan Kamantan (Kaduna state, Nigeria) where the priest's home has been burned down and seminary student Naaman Danlami murdered; may He sustain them, comfort them as they mourn and grant them the courage and strength to persevere in witness to our Risen Lord Jesus Christ, the hope of all the nations.
