Prayers for our persecuted brothers, sisters and Churches

'The Son is the image of the invisible God, the first-born over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the first-born from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.' (Colossians 1:15-20)

MONDAY: Please pray for all our brothers and sisters in Pakistan where Christians face sustained persecution from the majority religion and at best indifference from the authorities and where there have been several atrocities in recent years targeting churches and communities. (Source: RI) TUESDAY: Please pray for the family of fourteen year-old Sunil Masih (of Gujranwala, Punjab province) who was shot dead by a gunman shouting anti-Christian threats two weeks ago, that He will comfort them and keep them safe. (Source: R I)

WEDNESDAY: Please pray for the survivors of the Islamist mob violence last summer in Jaranwala (Punjab province) who still seek justice; may He grant them peace to rebuild their lives and may justice flow like a river and the schemes of the wicked be confounded. (Source: R I)

THURSDAY: Please pray for the Presbyterian church in Gujranwala where services have been disrupted and the building attacked; may He protect them and shelter them. (Source: R I) FRIDAY: Please pray for Azam & Nadeem Masih (of Sialkot) who were abducted, tortured & then forcibly converted to Islam, that He will lead them to a place of safety where they can find restoration and renewal in the arms of their loving Saviour who died for them and who still loves them. (Source: R I)

SATURDAY: Please pray for the leadership of the Pakistani churches, that He will grant them wisdom, discernment and patience and be in their labours, especially those of the president of the Churches of Pakistan, Bishop Azad Marshall as he and his fellow leaders engage the authorities to ensure justice and fairness and equality for all the nation's Christians. (Source: RI) SUNDAY: Please pray for all Pakistanis who are afraid or threatened or have suffered for their faith; that He will bless them & walk with them, live them up and shower them with the blessings of His great love and enduring faithfulness and that they all know, however dark the hour, that nothing can separate them from His love.
