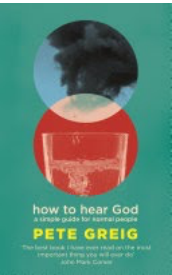

Prayers for our persecuted Churches and our Brothers and Sisters

'For everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.' (1 John 5.4-5)

MONDAY: Please pray for the Bible Reformed Church in Guangzhou (China) whose building has been confiscated and their meetings broken up; that the LORD will bless them and hear their prayers. (Source: Release International)

TUESDAY: Please pray for pastors Nguyen Trung Ton, Pham Van Troi & Truong Minh Duc (of Vietnam), all imprisoned since 2018 for their faith; may they know God's steadfast love as they put their trust in Him. (Source: CSW / Psalm 143)

WEDNESDAY: Please pray for the Christians in Gezira province (Sudan) whose church at Wad Mahani has been burned down & homes looted, that He will save them from the hands of the wicked and deliver them from the grasp of the cruel. (Source: CSW / Jeremiah 15.21)
