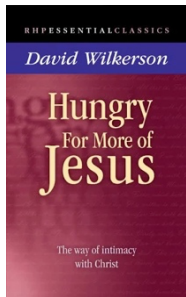

Prayers for our persecuted Churches and our Brothers and Sisters

'The LORD is my light and my salvation - whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life - of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked advance against me to devour me, it is my enemies and my foes who will stumble and fall' (Psalm 27.1-2)

MONDAY: Please pray for China Aid, Release International's partner working with Chinese Christians and its leader Bob Fu, that their work will be blessed and powerful despite the intimidation and threats made against them (Source: Release International)

TUESDAY: Please pray for Leah Sharibu in Nigeria who will be 21 today who has been held by extremist kidnappers for over six years now; may she and her family know the favour of the LORD this day and may He fill her with grace and courage as she stands firm for her redeemer. (Source: CSW)

WEDNESDAY: Please pray for Hao Ming, a church elder from Deyang (China) who is in prison for 'fraud' (raising a collection from the congregation directly rather than through the party-controlled banks) that he will be kept safe and strong and covered by the grace of the LORD. (Source: Release International)

THURSDAY: Please pray for Pastor Wang Yi, of the Early Rain Covenant Church in China now spending his sixth year in prison; that the LORD will uphold the cause of the oppressed in China, set the prisoners free and lift up those who are bowed down because He loves the righteous whose hope is in the LORD their God but frustrates the ways of the wicked. FRIDAY: Please pray for the Christians of Jaranwala (Pakistan) where 23 churches & 80 homes were burned last year; that the LORD will keep His people safe and be in their rebuilding of their homes and churches. (Source: Release International)

SATURDAY: Please pray for ninety-one year old Chinese Bishop, James Su Zhi Min, who has been seen only once in public since his re-arrest in 1997; may the LORD be his rock of refuge to which he can always go for He is our rock and our fortress. (Source: CSW / Psalm 71.3)

SUNDAY: Please pray for the Christian community in Egypt who are being increasingly persecuted by those angered by the war between Israel & the Palestinians, the LORD will keep them from all harm, watch over their lives and watch over their comings & goings now and forever more. (Source: Release International / Psalm 121.7-8)
