Prayer of the Needy - Exodus 22:22-24

"You must not exploit a widow or an orphan. If you exploit them in any way and they cry out to me, then I will certainly hear their cry. My anger will blaze against you, and I will kill you with the sword. Then your wives will be widows and your children fatherless.

When the widows and fatherless have no language but a cry, God registers the cry. He is never indifferent to the prayer of the afflicted when they plead for deliverance from injustice. If human tribunals fail to administer justice. God intervenes to deliver His own who cry to Him day and night. The court of Heaven is open to plead, judge and avenge the cause of the oppressed.
