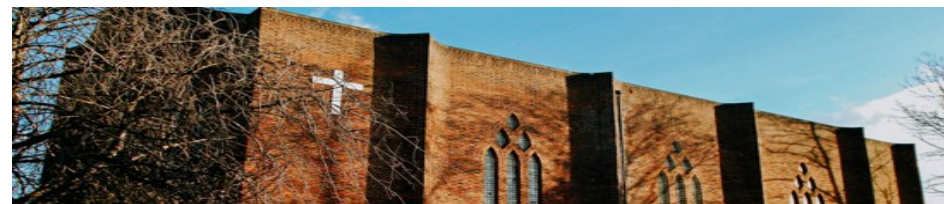

COUNTRY	ESTIMATED CHRISTIANS	PLEASE PRAY AGAINST
Bhutan	19,500 (0.2%)	Religious nationalism
Mexico	126.9 million (95.5%)	Organised crime and corruption
Egypt	9.8 million (9.1%)	Islamic oppression
Mozambique	19.2 million (56.4%)	Islamic oppression
Quatar	414,000 (13.7%)	Islamic oppression

Bhutan, churches are not officially recognised by the government, so all Christian gatherings are illegal. All Bhutanese are expected to follow Buddhism, Christians can gather informally in quiet – attracting no attention.
