We pray for:

Our brothers & sisters who have experienced violent attacks, for the families of martyrs, for those who have been forced to flee and for those who have been kidnapped; that the Lord will make them dwell in safety & let the light of His face shine upon them

Release International's partners & all other Christian aid agencies on the ground who are working to provide food, shelter, medical supplies, Bibles, trauma counselling & training for local pastors to share the hope of the gospel in these times - that they will know in their hearts that He is risen, that the needy are not forgotten and that the hope of the afflicted will never perish

For the Nigerian government, to act justly, to listen to all its citizens and to fulfil its duty to protect its citizens; that the Lord will answer those who call upon Him in distress with the saving power of His right hand so that those who trust not in chariots or horses but in the name of the Lord our God will rise up & stand firm and be given the desire of their hearts
